**ORDER ESTABLISHING COMMENT PERIOD ON
PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES OF
CIVIL APPELLATE PROCEDURE**

In a report dated June 28, 2023, the Minnesota Supreme Court Advisory Committee for the Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure has recommended several amendments to the Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure. These include amendments to Rule 110.02, subds. 2 and 4 regarding transcripts; Rule 120.02 regarding service of extraordinary writs upon the trial court; Rule 129.02 regarding the filing and service of amicus briefs; Rule 131.03 regarding the service of paper copies of briefs and addenda; Rule 143.05, subd. 3 regarding supervised practitioners; and Rule 144 regarding timelines for notifying the attorney general that a party is challenging the constitutionality of a statute and for the attorney general to file their intervention and brief.¹ The committee's report with the proposed amendments is available on the public access site for the Minnesota Appellate Courts, under case number ADM09-

¹ The Advisory Committee also provided recommendations in response to the Minnesota State Bar Association's petition to amend the appellate rules to permit an automatic extension of briefing deadlines and postponement of oral argument for certain personal, family, or medical reasons. That recommendation was put out for public comment in a separate order. Order Establishing Public Comment Period and Hearing on Proposed Amendments to Minnesota Rules of General Practice, Minnesota Rules of Civil Procedure, and Minnesota Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure, Nos. ADM09-8009, ADM04-8001, ADM09-8006 (Minn. filed Aug. 11, 2023).

The court will consider the proposed amendments to the Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure after providing a period for public comment and reviewing any comments on the proposed amendments.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that any person or organization wishing to provide written comments in support of or in opposition to the proposed amendments to the Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure shall file those comments with the Clerk of the Appellate Courts using the appellate courts' e-filing application, E-MACS, if required to do so. *See* Minn. R. Civ. App. P. 125.01(a). All comments shall be filed so as to be received by the Clerk's office no later than Monday, October 16, 2023.
