

McLeod/Sibley ENE Provider Roster Criteria

PROVIDER CRITERIA

Requirements of all candidates

1. ENE Training
2. Observations:
 - a. SENE: 3 observations with 3 different evaluators. If the candidate has been a participant in an SENE, it counts as an observation. However, at least one observation must be as non-participant observer. The best practices for a SENE would be two individuals, a man and a woman team, but no requirement for the team to be an attorney/non-attorney.
 - b. FENE: 1 observation as a non-participant observer.
3. Availability and willingness to schedule session dates in the near future, (usually within two weeks of the contact date).
4. Agrees to abide by the county fee schedule for payment of services.

Additional requirements for attorneys:

1. In good standing.
2. A minimum of 5 years family law experience.
3. Family law trial or contested hearing experience.

Additional requirements for non-attorneys:

1. Master degree/Professional license (CPA for Financial early neutral evaluations)
2. In good standing in professional licensure area.
3. A minimum of 5 years of experience working with families and children/dissolution.
