*The initial SENE and FENE 3-hour sessions are billed as flat fees and the total amount is due even if the session ends early. Additional time spent after the first three hours is billed at the hourly rate.

Travel Fee:

A flat rate travel fee of \$25 shall be paid to any provider needing to travel more than 25 miles one way from his/her registered "home base" location (whichever is closer to the county = office or home address) per session. Parties are to split equally (unless judge sets other division) the travel fee (i.e. each party pays \$12.50 if only one provider traveling beyond 25 miles or \$25 if both providers traveling beyond 25 miles.) This is in addition to the initial 3-hour session fee and any additional hourly fees paid. If more than one session (meeting time) is needed, the travel fee shall be paid for each session. [Basically, the travel fee applies to any provider coming from outside of Grand Rapids.]
