We are writing on behalf of Comerica Bank & Trust, N.A. (“Personal Representative”), in response to your instruction on July 10, 2018, to provide comments regarding the process for submission and review of the Remanded Fee Issue proposed by Mr. Kane.

We propose that any and all parties wishing to weigh-in on the Remanded Fee Issue—including Mr. Kane, Mr. Bruntjen, Mr. Wheaton, any of the Heirs or their current counsel, or the Personal Representative—be required to do so by letter brief by Friday July 20, 2018. We further propose that after July 20, parties should only be permitted to file replies or any other further submissions if specifically ordered to do so by the Special Master. This procedure will ensure that all parties have the opportunity to present argument in advance of the July 25, 2018 hearing while minimizing the total amount of briefing and limiting further submissions to only those you believe will actually assist in reaching a decision.
