ORDER ADOPTING STIPULATION

The above-entitled matter came before the Court on January 23, 2019, upon Lommen Abdo, P.A.'s, Skolnick & Joyce, P.A.'s, and Hanson, Dordell, Bradt, Odlaug & Bradt, P.L.L.P.'s (collectively "the Firms") applications for attorneys' liens.

Michael Kemp, Esq. and Paul Funke, Esq. appeared on behalf of Hanson, Dordell, Bradt,

Sharon Nelson appeared pro se. Norrine Nelson was also present at the hearing.

Following the hearing, the Court took the matter under advisement. On March 26, 2019, the Firms reached a stipulation related to their claimed attorneys' liens. That stipulation was submitted to the Court. The stipulation provides that the Firms have agreed to equal/coordinate priority amongst their respective attorneys' liens. The stipulation further provides that the Firms have agreed to an equal division of any proceeds to be received by SNJ from the Estate or from proceeds involved in or affected by the Estate proceeding, which could satisfy, in whole or in part, any of the Firm's respective attorneys' liens. When making these divisions, no firm may receive more than the unsatisfied portion of its attorneys' lien, and any excess balance beyond

what is paid to satisfy one of the Firm's attorneys' liens will be evenly divided between the remaining two firms.

ORDER

- 1. The Firms' stipulation is adopted by the Court.
- 2. The Firms' attorneys' liens each share coordinate priority.
- 3. Any distributions or payments made to satisfy the Firms' attorneys' liens shall be evenly divided between the Firms, subject to the terms of the stipulation.
