ORDER REGARDING
ELECTRONIC SERVICE EVENTS

Deceased.

The above-entitled matter came on for review before the Honorable Kevin W. Eide without a hearing. The case record contains a large number of electronic service events, which have slowed case processing and access to the case through Minnesota Public Access (“MPA”). Technology is now available to move individual electronic service events from the case Register of Actions to a report (“Service Event Report”) added to the case record, which will improve case processing and public access to the case.

Therefore, based on the file and proceedings herein, the Court makes the following:

ORDER

1. Carver County Court Administration and the State Court Administrator’s Office shall take the steps necessary to move individual electronic service events from the case Register of Actions to Service Event Reports.
2. Electronic service events in the current case volume and Volume D will be moved to Service Event Reports. The Service Event Reports shall be generated and added to the case record within a reasonable time after entry of this order based on staff resources.
3. Additional Service Event Reports may be run as court administration determines necessary to improve case processing and performance, and without further order. These reports may be run in the current or previous volumes.
4. The Service Event Reports are official court records of service in this matter, along with the individual electronic service events and other filed records of service.

5. Carver County Court Administration shall provide copies of this Order to the parties, or their attorneys of record, upon entry.
