E. Nilsson has been consulted and does not object to making a squad car available for Inspection

upon the following conditions:

- 1. No destructive testing will be conducted upon the MPD squad car;
- 2. The MPD will select appropriate representatives to assist in providing access to the squad car, at their discretion. Only MPD representatives may drive the squad car.
- 3. The Defense will not interview, question, or otherwise seek information from the MPD representatives in attendance at the Inspection.
- 4. The Defense agrees that they will be responsible for any damages or liability caused by or resulting from the actions of their agents, employees, or counsel in the course of their Inspection, including, but not limited to, personal injury and property damage.

IT IS NOW ordered that the City of Minneapolis shall allow the defense access to a

squad car to perform an Inspection on December 28, 2018 pursuant to conditions 1 through 4

above. The squad will be available for Inspection in the area of Minneapolis Police

Department's 5th Precinct between the hours of 6:00 PM and 11:00 PM on December 28, 2018.
