**ORDER**

**BASED ON THE FILE, RECORD, AND PROCEEDINGS, AND BECAUSE:**

1. This appeal was filed by mail on September 20, 2021.
2. On November 12, 2021, court reporter Dana Carmichael filed a certificate as to transcript for proceedings on 32 different dates. In the certificate, the reporter estimated that the reporter would complete the 6,000-page transcript by December 21, 2021.
3. On December 7, 2021, reporter Carmichael filed a motion for an extension until January 18, 2022, to complete the transcript. The motion states that the reporter needs additional time to complete the transcript due the length of the transcript and the reporter's current workload. The motion indicates that counsel of record do not object to the requested extension.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**


1. The motion of court reporter Dana Carmichael for an extension to complete the transcript is granted.

2. On or before January 18, 2022, reporter Carmichael shall (a) file the transcript with the district court administrator, (b) deliver the transcript to counsel for the parties, and (c) file a certificate of transcript filing and delivery with the clerk of the appellate courts via E-MACS.

3. The clerk of the appellate courts shall provide copies of this order to the Honorable Peter A. Cahill, counsel of record, the district court administrator, and court reporter Dana Carmichael.
