

New Pretrial Interim Conditions



Overview

Effective October 5, 2018 pretrial release conditions for defendants will change. This change supports the upcoming implementation of the Minnesota Pretrial Release Evaluation Form and Assessment Tool (MNPAT).

New Interim Conditions

This table lists the new conditions and definitions. Note that more than one of these options may be ordered for a defendant. This means that the defendant may choose between these options. For example, the judicial officer may order the conditions Post Cash Bail with No Conditions with an amount of \$1,000 and Post Cash Bail with Conditions with an amount of \$300. The defendant would then have the option to pay \$1,000 and be released with no other conditions or pay \$300 and be released with other conditions.

Condition	Definition
Hold Without Bail or Bond	Judicial officer orders the defendant to remain in custody.
Post Bail or Bond with Conditions	Judicial officer orders the defendant to pay a certain amount to be released from custody along with other release conditions, such as no same or similar, abstain from alcohol, etc. The judicial officer does not indicate cash bail or non-cash bond.
Post Bail or Bond with No Conditions	Judicial officer orders the defendant to pay a certain amount to be released from custody. The judicial officer does not indicate cash bail or non-cash bond. No other condition(s) are ordered.
Post Cash Bail with Conditions	Judicial officer orders the defendant to pay cash bail to be released from custody along with other release conditions, such as no same or similar, abstain from alcohol, etc.
Post Cash Bail with No Conditions	Judicial officer orders the defendant to pay cash bail to be released from custody. No other condition(s) are ordered.
Post Non-Cash Bond with Conditions	Judicial officer orders the defendant to pay non-cash bond to be released from custody along with other release conditions, such as no same or similar, abstain from alcohol, etc.
Post Non-Cash Bond with No Conditions	Judicial officer orders the defendant to pay non-cash bond to be released from custody. No other condition(s) are ordered.
Release with Conditions	Judicial officer orders the defendant to be released from custody with specific conditions, other than bail or bond.
Release with No Bail, Bond, or Conditions of Release	Judicial officer orders the defendant to be released from custody without ordering any cash bail, non-cash bond, or release conditions.
