As an affected White Earth Reservation Tribal Member, I would like to comment on the following topics during this hearing:

- The Minnesota Chippewa Tribe's Special Meeting held March 14, 2017 that called for a Constitutional Convention to address Rule 10 before actual implementation occurs in the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe. The Tribal Executive Committee agreed to postpone Rule 10 until the Convention has convened
- The extension of full faith and credit and its impact on Tribal members
- Findings of the October 29, 2002 State of Minnesota Supreme Court, CX-89-1863 hearing to consider petition for adoption of a rule of procedure for the recognition of Tribal Court Orders and judgments
- No separation of powers in Tribal government and its effect on Tribal Court decisions
- Application of the Revised Constitution and Bylaws of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe, Thomas v. U.S., et al, and Jacobson v Massachusetts, 197 U.S.. 11, 22 (1905)
