

REVOKED LICENSE - send the following forms to the state DPS Driver & Vehicle Services office:

- Participation Agreement signed & dated
- Proof of insurance
- Special Review Awareness form signed & notarized if you have had more than one DWI

CANCELLED LICENSE - send the following forms to the state DPS Driver & Vehicle Services office:

- Participation Agreement signed & dated
- Last Use Statement signed & notarized or signed by a DPS representative
- Completed chemical use assessment that includes your dated of birth or driver's license number faxed by provider to DVS 651-797-1738
- Proof of Insurance

Fifth Judicial District Eligibility Criteria for Ignition Interlock Assistance

- Resident of Blue Earth, Brown, Cottonwood, Faribault, Jackson, Lincoln, Lyon, Martin, Murray, Nicollet, Nobles, Pipestone, Redwood, Rock and Watonwan County
- On pre-trial, probation, or supervised release
- Have more than one DWI on record or a BAC at or above 0.16 on a first-time DWI
- Submit completed Fifth Judicial District application for Ignition Interlock Assistance and meet household income guidelines.

Fifth Judicial District Application Form

You may pick up an application from your probation agent or online at: www.mncourts.gov/Fifth-Ignition-Interlock-Program. You will receive a letter indicating your level of eligibility and the next steps to follow.

Installation Assistance

Some eligible participants of the Fifth Judicial District's Ignition Interlock Assistance Program may have the full cost of ignition interlock installation paid if the program has sufficient funds, and the completed application is received prior to installation.

Monthly Fee Assistance

Participants may also be eligible to receive help to pay the monthly cost to lease the Ignition Interlock device for up to 12 months. This could be a savings of \$30 to \$80 per month, depending on your household income level.

REVOKED or CANCELLED LICENSE: Steps to install Ignition Interlock

1. Make sure you're eligible to apply to install ignition interlock.
 - a. Age 18 or older
 - b. Own or have access to a vehicle (not a moped or motorcycle)
 - c. Vehicle is insured
 - d. Not subject to Vanessa's Law because of a DWI before 18
 - e. You have no other withdrawals on your license
2. Pay reinstatement fee, apply for a new Class D license and purchase new plates if yours were impounded.
3. Complete Driver & Vehicle Services (DVS) forms and submit via fax, upload, or email.

4. Complete the Fifth District's Application Form, available on its website: www.mncourts.gov/Fifth-Ignition-Interlock-Program

5. If eligible for funding through the Fifth District, notify the Ignition Interlock Coordinator once you are approved to install ignition interlock at 507-388-2181 so that payment arrangements are in place **BEFORE** installation.

6. Install Ignition Interlock, but **DO NOT DRIVE** until notified you are able to do so by DVS. Have someone drive you to and from your installation appointment.

Valid License and COURT-ORDERED: Steps to install Ignition Interlock

1. Complete the Fifth Judicial District's Application Form, available on its website: www.mncourts.gov/Fifth-Ignition-Interlock-Program

2. Coordinate installation with an Ignition Interlock vendor to ensure payment arrangements are in place.
