

Ignition Interlock Program Checklist

(Use this checklist if your license has been cancelled)

Please note: All office appointments with the 5^{th} Judicial District Program Coordinator need to be scheduled in advance.

Am I eligible to apply for the <u>Ignition Interlock</u> Program?		
	Age 18 and eligible for Class D license (no other license classes are eligible to install ignition interlock)	
	Own or able to drive a vehicle – not a moped or motorcycle	
	My vehicle is insured	
	I am not subject to Vanessa's Law because of a DWI before age 18	
	I have no other withdrawals on my license (ex. lost license due to failure to pay child support)	
I have gone to my local DVS office to do the following:		
Go to <u>www.mndrive.info</u> to find a local DVS office		
	Purchased new plates (if your plates were impounded)	
	Paid the \$680 reinstatement fee – the Partial Payment Program may assist with the cost	
	Completed application for a new Class D license and kept my receipt	
Once you've completed all of the above you are ready to apply to install ignition interlock.		
Read the Minnesota Ignition Interlock Device <u>Program Guidelines</u> available online at www.dps.mn.gov		
Send the following forms to the Ignition Interlock Unit (fax paperwork to #651-797-1299 except treatment		
paperwork) or upload the forms:		
	Signed and date the <u>Ignition Interlock Participation Agreement</u>	
	Sign and notarize or have a DPS representative sign the <u>Last Use Statement</u>	
	Complete chemical use assessment. Treatment provider must fax (fax #651-797-1738) assessment and proof of enrollment, if applicable, to DVS. Include your driver's license number or date of birth.	
	Submit insurance for the vehicle to be equipped with the device. Proof of insurance is needed for an offense	
	on or after 7/1/21 if there is no insurance conviction on record. An SR-22 insurance certificate is required	
	for anyone with a prior conviction for no insurance. The VIN (Vehicle Identification Number) of the vehicle	
	with the device must match the VIN on the Certificate of Insurance.	
AND send the following forms to the Fifth Judicial District's Ignition Interlock Coordinator:		
	Signed and dated Application and Acknowledgment form for Ignition Interlock	
When you get a letter from Driver & Vehicle Services that your ignition interlock application has been approved:		
	Contact the 5 th Judicial District Ignition Interlock Program Coordinator to set up funding (Jackie Murray :

	Choose a certified ignition interlock manufacturer Minnesota Ignition Interlock Program - Certified Ignition	
	Interlock Manufacturers (mn.gov)	
	Schedule ignition interlock installation – tell them you are in the "5 th Judicial District Ignition Interlock	
	Program"
