Judges perform ceremonies Monday-Friday and by appointment at open [courthouse locations](#) (Family Justice Center, Juvenile Justice Center, or Brookdale and Ridgedale Regional Service Centers). If a wedding is to occur during the work week at a courthouse, it must be before 8:00 a.m. or after 4:30 p.m., unless the judge agrees to perform a ceremony during the work day while taking vacation leave. Check with individual judges for other arrangements such as weekend or evening ceremonies or locations other than the courthouse. Request specific instructions from judges' staff regarding building access outside of regular business hours.

Remember to bring the following to your marriage ceremony:

- Marriage license issued by any [Hennepin County Service Center](#)
- A photo ID for each applicant
- Two witnesses (or request the court provide them)
