STANDING ORDER

Order Authorizing Filings of Pleadings Without payment of filing fees (in forma pauperis) For Adult Representation Services

- 1. Whereas, Hennepin County Adult Representation Services is appointed to represent indigent parties in certain Family Court cases, including Child support Contempt, Paternity, and Servicemember Civil Relief Act (SCRA) appointments;
- 2. Whereas, Hennepin County Adult Representation Services will also be representing certain indigent child support obligors in Child Support Modification matters as part of its holistic prevention practice;
- 3. Whereas, the parties represented by Hennepin County Adult Representation Services often need to file pleadings, especially in cases under the Parentage Act;
- 4. Whereas, only indigent parties qualify for Hennepin County Adult Representation Services;

The Court makes the following:

STANDING ORDER

- 1. Hennepin County District Court Administration shall accept for filing any pleading in the above-entitled cases from Hennepin County Adult Representation Services (or any person in their employment) without the necessity of paying any filing fees.
- 2. This order updates and replaces the Standing Order on fees dated February 26, 2007, and remains in effect until revoked or further order of this Court.
