# STEPS TO SEAL THE RECORDS OF YOUR JUVENILE DELINQUENCY FOR FREE

Not all felonies are eligible for seal. For a complete list of eligible offenses see MN Stat. 609A.02, Subd. 3



## WHEN AM I ELIGIBLE?

If a case was dismissed in your favor (e.g. an acquittal or not guilty verdict), you may be eligible **NOW**.



If you received a continuance without a plea, a stay of adjudication, or diversion, wait **1 YEAR** from the date you were last under court/probation supervision.



If you were adjudicated delinquent of any misdemeanor juvenile offense except for the following: criminal sexual conduct, domestic violence, gun cases, and arson and fire cases, wait **1 YEAR** from the date you were last under court/probation supervision.



If you were adjudicated delinquent of a gross misdemeanor juvenile offense except for the following: criminal sexual conduct, domestic violence, gun cases, and arson and fire cases, wait **2 YEARS** from the date you were last under court/probation supervision.

If you were adjudicated delinquent of a felony juvenile offense for Theft, Felony Damage to Property, Check Forgery, Burglary in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree, Felony Motor Vehicle Theft, Felony Drug Possession in the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, or 5<sup>th</sup> degree, wait **3 YEARS** from the date you were last under court/probation supervision. Other felonies listed in Minn. Stat. 609A.02, Subd. 3 are also eligible offenses.
