WHEN AM I ELIGIBLE?

If a case was dismissed in your favor (e.g. an acquittal or not guilty verdict), you may be eligible **NOW**.

If you received a continuance without a plea, a stay of adjudication, or diversion, wait **1 YEAR** from the date you were last under court/probation supervision.

If you were adjudicated delinquent of any <u>misdemeanor</u> juvenile offense except for the following: criminal sexual conduct, domestic violence, gun cases, and arson and fire cases, wait **1 YEAR** from the date you were last under court/probation supervision.

If you were adjudicated delinquent of a <u>gross misdemeanor</u> juvenile offense except for the following: criminal sexual conduct, domestic violence, gun cases, and arson and fire cases, wait **2 YEARS** from the date you were last under court/probation supervision.

If you were adjudicated delinquent of a <u>felony</u> juvenile offense for Theft, Felony Damage to Property, Check Forgery, Burglary in the 3rd Degree, Felony Motor Vehicle Theft, Felony Drug Possession in the 3rd, 4th, or 5th degree, wait **3 YEARS** from the date you were last under court/probation supervision. Other felonies listed in Minn. Stat. 609A.02, Subd. 3 are also eligible offenses.
