STANDING ORDER

---

WHEREAS, Hennepin County Department of Community Corrections and Rehabilitation (DOCCR) has created a consolidated Electronic Home Monitoring (EHM) unit to provide increased accountability for persons on EHM as a court ordered condition of probation or pretrial release;

WHEREAS, the DOCCR EHM unit will promptly respond to alerts and violations 24 hours per day, 365 days per year;

WHEREAS, the DOCCR EHM unit will utilize an EHM Response Grid in determining when to initiate a warrantless arrest of a person in violation of EHM supervision rules; and,

THEREFORE, THE FOLLOWING SHALL BE THE STANDING ORDER OF THE COURT:

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 629.355, the DOCCR EHM Division Manager or designee may initiate a warrantless arrest by a peace officer of a person being supervised on EHM when there is probable cause to believe that the person has violated an EHM rule.
2. No person arrested pursuant to this Order may be detained longer than the period provided in rule 27.04, subdivision 1(2), Minnesota Rules of Criminal Procedure.
