STANDING ORDER REGARDING PARTY STATUS OF CHILDREN AND PARENTS AND RECEIPT OF DISCOVERY

TO: All parties to matters filed in Hennepin County Juvenile Court under Minnesota Statutes Ch. 260C

WHEREAS, the Hennepin County Attorney (HCAO), Public Defender (PDO) and Adult Representation Services (ARS) collaborated to build a program that electronically exchanges discovery in child protection cases;

WHEREAS, Hennepin Justice Integration Program (HJIP), a county-funded initiative, provided additional resources to the Child Protection eDiscovery project in order to improve system efficiencies for the justice partners;

WHEREAS, ARS is fiscally responsible for providing representation for all parents experiencing indigence in child protection cases;

WHEREAS, ARS has contracted with the Indian Child Welfare Act Law Center (ICWALC) for parent representation on some cases filed pursuant to the Indian Child Welfare Act (ICWA);

WHEREAS, ARS has contracted with outside counsel for parent representation on conflict cases;

WHEREAS, more than 90% of the child protection cases in Hennepin County are assigned to ARS, PDO, ICWALC and ARS conflict contractors;

WHEREAS, as a matter of law, all PDO and ARS clients are eligible for party status as a matter of right pursuant to Minn. R. Juv. Prot. Proc. 34.01;

WHEREAS, early access to discovery improves the quality of representation for parents and children in child protection cases and avoids unnecessary delay;

WHEREAS, the PDO and ARS have requested that all clients who are eligible and appointed representation be deemed parties in child protection cases; and

WHEREAS, the HCAO will provide discovery to PDO, ARS, and ARS contracted counsel and organizations appointed on child protection cases for parents and children in child protection cases.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. All children and parents who are deemed eligible for and appointed representation through ARS, PDO, or ARS contracted counsel shall automatically be deemed parties in child protection cases.
- 2. The HCAO shall provide discovery to PDO, ARS, and ARS contracted counsel and organizations appointed on child protection cases for parents and children in child protection cases.
