STANDING ORDER

TO: All police departments located in Hennepin County

Pursuant to this Court's power and discretion under Minnesota Statutes §260B.171, governing juvenile records; and

Consistent with the policy embodied in Minnesota Statutes §260B.171, subdivision 4(c) and Minnesota Statutes §13.84, subdivisions 6(a)(2) and 6(c), regarding victim access to juvenile records, as well as Minnesota Statutes §260B.198, subdivision 1(5), Minnesota Statutes §260B.235, subdivision 4(6), regarding restitution to victims;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED

All police departments located in Hennepin County shall, upon presentation of appropriate identification, provide to:

1. any person named in a police report as a victim of a delinquent act committed by a juvenile, which would be a crime if committed by an adult; and
2. any person named in a police or accident report as a victim in a traffic offense committed by a juvenile

the following information:


- the juvenile's name, last known address, date of birth, and place of employment;
- the name and last known address of the juvenile's parents and guardians; and
- the factual part of the police report(s) related to the investigation of the delinquent act or traffic offense.

This Order does not require the police department to release any information where the police department determines that the release of the requested information could interfere with an on-going police investigation.
