The Legal Clinic is a free service dedicated to helping self-represented people who have a case in Ramsey County Family Court. Experienced Family Law attorneys staff this clinic.

- This free service provides advice to people who represent themselves in Family Court.
- This clinic is limited to parties with existing Ramsey County Family Court cases or parties intending to file a case in Ramsey County. The attorney cannot provide advice to parties who have cases in other jurisdictions.
- There are no income restrictions to use this service.
- Volunteer attorneys staff this free legal clinic. They offer advice regarding Family Law matters such as:
 - Divorce
 - Child Custody
 - Child Support
 - Parenting Time
 - Paternity
- Volunteer attorneys do not assist with appeals, annulment of marriage, legal separation, grandparent visitation, or any issues in legal areas other than Family Law.
- Volunteer attorneys can provide answers to legal questions, offer procedural advice, and explain court orders. No attorney-client relationship is established. **Volunteer attorneys will not represent you in court.**
- Clients are seen by appointment only. Appointments will not be conducted over the phone. Appointments last approximately 15 minutes. Children are not allowed in the appointment.
