ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING IN PERSON HEARING COVID SAFETY PROTOCOLS

WHEREAS, on July 27, 2021, based on new evidence of spread of the B.1.617.2 (Delta) variant of COVID-19 the Centers for Disease Control (“CDC”) updated mask recommendations for indoor settings in areas of substantial or high transmission of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, on July 30, 2021, in response to the new recommendations Minnesota Supreme Court Justice Lori Gildea modified order ADM20-8001 to provide that presiding judges, in consultation with the chief judge of the district, may require parties, participants, and those who attend an in-person proceeding to wear a face covering during the proceeding,

WHEREAS, Isanti County was recently identified by the CDC as an area of substantial transmission;

WHEREAS, the fairness of court proceedings and the health, safety and well-being of those exercising their rights and duties as it relates to those proceedings in Isanti County is the court’s highest priority;

IT IS ORDERED THAT: masks shall be worn by all persons in courtrooms and jury waiting and deliberation rooms for all in-person Isanti County proceedings until further order of the court.
