



2021 CRIMINAL EXPUNGEMENT CLINIC – FREE

Expungement is the process of going to court to ask a judge to seal a court record. People request an expungement when they have been denied a job, housing, or a professional license because of a criminal incident that shows up on a background check.

Attend a virtual informational session via Zoom to learn more about the expungement process and have general questions answered by attorneys. If you do not have access to technology required to attend a Zoom session, the Anoka County Law Library will reserve computers for that use. **Sessions start at 2:30 p.m.**

Some individuals may also be eligible for personalized consultations following the Zoom session. More information will be provided about personalized consultations during the presentation.

Court forms will be provided to all registrants, or they can be picked up at the Law Library for free.
